Proposed carbon tax plan could increase electricity costs



You already know these are hard economic times for America's families. Many are struggling to afford the basics – food, housing and energy costs. The cost of electricity has already increased 40% since 2002, and there are signs that electric cooperatives will have to raise rates again.

Legislative efforts to address climate change concerns by limiting emissions of carbon dioxide (CO₂) and other greenhouse gases are part of the national energy strategy that has taken center-stage in Washington, D.C. President Obama's budget jumpstarted the debate by proposing that Congress auction 100 percent emissions using the Clean Air Act. No matter the option, consumers and the economy are facing new costs as CO₂ emissions are priced and controlled.

With your help we can urge Congress to work with electric co-ops to meet both federal public policy goals and your need for affordable, reliable electricity.

What does this do to the end user? Under the plan by the US

Senate and House of Representatives, consumers could be forced to pay for carbon (CO₂) emission reduction by paying more for the energy they use.

This bill will require generation facilities like Associated Electric Cooperative Inc. to purchase CO₂ permits from a cap-andtrade program in order to operate. The plan could increase monthly electric bills for co-op members, depending on the amount of the carbon tax. If congress passes a CO₂ cap-and-trade program members could see an increase of 17% to 25% in their electric bills.

We need answers, 839000 and as your electric cooperative we stand ready to work with members of congress to get the job done.

What can you do? If you have internet access, log on to **www.ourenergy.coop** and urge Congress to work with electric co-ops to meet both federal public policy goals and your need for affordable, reliable electricity.
