






Jeremy Baker Graduates OAEC Powerline Training Program

Cookson Hills Electric Cooperative congratulates Jeremy Baker on recently completing the Oklahoma Association of Electric Cooperatives Powerline Training Program. Baker's completion of the four-year program has earned him the certification of Journeyman Electric Lineman.

In order to become a Journeyman Lineman at CHEC, an individual must complete this four year apprentice training program, conducted through OAEC. The apprentice training program has been developed in cooperation with the Safety and Loss Control Department of the OAEC for use by member systems in the comprehensive development of their employees. The course is comprised of twelve units, each including on-the-job training, independent study and hands-on skills training conducted at regularly scheduled workshops.

Upon the successful completion of all twelve units and a passing score on the final exam, Baker has been issued a certificate approved by the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprentices and Training certifying that Baker has met the requirements for the OAEC Powerline Training Program and is certified as a Journeyman Electric Lineman.

Are you on a residential rate? Is your electric bill due before you get paid? If you answered yes to these questions, you may want to consider switching to our new optional due date.

If you switch to our optional due date, your bill will be due by the first day of each month. You will also be required to remain on the new billing cycle for twelve months before being able to switch back to the original billing cycle.

The way the transition works:

• You will receive your regular monthly which is due by the 15th of the month.

• You will then be billed for approximately fit days usage which will be due by the 1st da the following month.

CFL Improper Uses

One of the benefits of using compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)—other than significant energy savings—is that each bulb can last up to 10,000 hours, if used correctly. While CFLs can fit into nearly any light fixture, they are not always a perfect choice. Consider these CFL "don'ts" to extend the life of your energy efficient bulbs:

Don't use a CFL in a fully enclosed, recessed fixture, as the heat will cause the CFL to work improperly. However, CFLs will generally work if the fixture is not completely recessed. Check the packaging to see if the CFL can be used in an inverted position.

2 Don't use a regular CFL with a dimmer switch. This will cause the bulb to burn out in days or weeks. Choose a CFL made specifically for use with dimmers.

Don't expect a regular CFL to produce three levels of brightness on a three-way switch. While a CFL will work properly on the middle switch, a regular CFL will not produce light like an incandescent bulb in a three-way switch. However, some manufacturers produce three-way CFLs.

Don't use a CFL where you turn the lights on and off a lot or leave them burning for just a few minutes at a time (like in the closet). Turning 1269000 the light on and off more than 20 times a day may negate the long lifespan of the bulb. CFLs are best for applications where the light will stay on for 15 minutes or longer.

5 Don't expose a CFL to the outdoor elements without a protective cover. Check the packaging for the range of operating temperatures.

Don't use a CFL in a fixture with a lot of vibration, such as a ceiling fan or in conjunction with a garage door opener. Vibrations can cause a CFL to fail.
